Mr. Hebel is a founding member, developer, and technical advisor for IAS, LLC. With over a decade of software development producing two top-selling software titles, he helped launch IAS in 2005. Since then, he continues to lead PC-based product development, handles internal communications systems, and is part of the long-range planning team. Mr. Hebel has a professional flying career spanning over 24 years of service with the United States Air Force, Air Force Reserve, and United Airlines, with expertise on the C-5 Galaxy, T-37, Airbus 319/320, and Boeing 727.

USAF Active Duty from 1986 to 2000: Primary jet training Instructor Aircraft Commander on the C-5 Galaxy and T-37. Tim was selected to train the initial cadre of pilots on the C-5 AMP aircraft (glass cockpit conversion). His management experience includes Flight Commander, Chief of Squadron Scheduling, and Assistant Operations Officer.

USAF Reserve 2000 to 2004: Tim created a squadron database to track training of over 250 individuals.

USAF Active Duty 2004 to 2008: Tim was responsible for the overall management of the initial C-5 Avionics Modernization Program (AMP) implementation, authored new procedures, was directly in charge of training and standardization of 550+ crew members in "glass" instrumentation and procedures. In addition, he coordinated new flight manual corrections and safety supplements, and assured AMP modification contract compliance as the chief AMP acceptance check flight pilot. A three-year member of AMP Crisis Management Team, he helped develop contingency plans and policies for unforeseen operational developments that kept the C-5 AMP fleet safely flying.

Mr. Hebel is additionally employed by United Airlines where he has experience as a First Officer on the Boeing 727 and the Airbus 319/320 aircraft family.
